Read Proverbs 1:1-7

Discuss

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What is the purpose of the book of Proverbs according to this passage?
- What is the "the fear of the LORD" (vs 7)?
- How is the "fear of the LORD the beginning of wisdom" (vs 7)?

The fear of the Lord is just the proper reaction of sinners to God's infinite holiness, or of creatures to God's infinite majesty. As we grow in the knowledge of God, we will learn truly to tremble before His great glory and burning purity, and see this as indeed the beginning of wisdom. - Eric Alexander

Kids Discussion Questions

- Proverbs is a book of wise sayings collected and written by King Solomon for his son. What does it mean to be wise?
- How is a wise man different than a man who knows many facts?
- Why would a father want his son to find wisdom?
- Solomon says the "fear of the Lord" is where knowledge begins (vs. 7). What does it mean to fear the Lord?

Read Proverbs 1:8-33 Discuss

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What warnings does Solomon give in verses 8-19?
- Starting in verse 20, Solomon describes Wisdom as a woman crying out in the street. How would you summarize her message?
- In verse 29 this theme of the fear of the Lord returns. How does
 Solomon show the relationship between wisdom and the fear of the Lord in this verse?

Kids Discussion Questions

- Why is it important to listen to our father's instruction and our mother's teaching (vs. 8)?
- Remember that Proverbs was put together by Solomon for his son.
 Right after Solomon tells his son to listen to his parents, he warns him not to listen to another group of people. Who is that?
- Why should we be careful not to listen to these people?

WEDNESDAY THE VALUE OF WISDOM

Read Proverbs 2

Discuss

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What encouragement does Solomon offer in verses 1-5?
- What will it take to find wisdom according to Solomon?
- Where can we find it?
- What does the life of a wise person look like from verses 9-20?

Job had asked, long before this, Where shall wisdom be found? Whence cometh wisdom? (Job 28:12, 20) and he had given this general answer (v. 23), God knoweth the place of it; but Solomon here goes further, and tells us both where we may find it and how we may get it. - Matthew Henry on verse 1-9

Kids Discussion Questions

- Solomon says that wisdom must be searched for like silver or hidden treasure (vs. 4). If you knew there was treasure hidden in your house, how long and how hard would you search for it?
- Where does wisdom come from? (hint: read verse 6).
- In this proverb, we see that wisdom is not only about what you know but also about how you live (vs. 7). What does it mean to "walk in integrity" (vs. 7)? Why is this wise?

THURSDAY TRUST IN THE LORD

Read Proverbs 3:1-12

Discuss

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What leads to "favor and good success in the sight of God and man" (vs. 4)?
- Why are we not to "lean on our own understanding" (vs. 5)?
- What does it look like to acknowledge the Lord in all our ways (vs. 6)?
- What is Solomon's message concerning the Lord's discipline (vs. 11)?
 What does the discipline of the Lord look like in the life of his children today?

While God is not pleased with my sin and may discipline me in order to turn me from destructive paths and practices, His love for me does not diminish in any degree. He gave himself for my sins in their entirety, so that I might have His love in its entirety... Accepting this reality of God's unchanging regard is necessary for us to make progress in the Christian life. - Bryan Chappel

Kids Discussion Questions

- Solomon tells us to trust in the Lord with all our hearts rather than our own understanding (vs. 5). What does it mean to trust "with all your heart"?
- Why should we always trust the Lord rather than ourselves?
- In verse 11-12 Solomon writes about discipline that comes from the Lord. Why do our parents discipline us? Why would the Lord do this and how can it help us?

Discuss

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What has stood out to you in our study in Proverbs this week?
- How does Solomon show wisdom to be an attribute of God?
- What rewards does Solomon list for finding wisdom?
- Read verse 33. Considering what's revealed in the New Testament, how can someone be made righteous in the sight of God?

To be justified means more than to be declared "not guilty." It actually means to be declared righteous before God. It means God has imputed or charged the guilt of our sin to His Son, Jesus Christ, and has imputed or credited Christ's righteousness to us. - Jerry Bridges

Kids Discussion Questions

- What is one thing you've learned from our time in Proverbs this week?
- In this proverb, Solomon shows that God is full of wisdom. In what ways has God shown his wisdom? (hint: for one example look at verse 19).
- Solomon tells us that the Lord blesses the righteous. How can we be made righteous before God? (hint: read 2 Corinthians 5:21).
