Discuss

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What stands out to you about this passage?
- How did John's ministry prepare the way for the Lord (vs. 23)?
- What would the phrase, "the lamb of God" mean to the Jewish audience of John's day?
- Given that John was the older cousin, how would you explain verse 30?
